The calendar needs to show the sources of livelihood/income on which the FUG members are dependent throughout the year and the months for which they are dependent on the particular source is also to be indicated on the chart. The micro plan should include the names of the Facilitating Team members and the Micro Planning Working Group members. Information will have to be provided as per the format on the status of village forest. Table no. 9 – Against the different types of forest produce which are to be arranged as per priority in the table the quantity required by villagers and the quantity actually available is to be mentioned. Table no. 10 (Species present in Village forest and their ranking) is missing. Please attach the filled up table. Resource map is not attached. Please attach it.

<p><u>Feedback on Micro Plan</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The no. of members in the FUG is only 27% of the Total no. of Households in the village. As per JFM Rules 2002 a relaxation is needed from the concerned Conservator of Forests in cases where the no. of HHs represented in the FUG is less than 50% of the total HHs in the village. The approval needs to be taken from the concerned Conservator. The no. of BPL families as mentioned will have to be verified with the official BPL List as available on mirzapur.nic.in The no. of FUG members is different in Table no. 2 and 5, needs to be rectified. Seasonal Calendar (Table 7) has been left almost blank as it doesn't show the sources of 		

income throughout the year. The calendar needs to show the sources of livelihood on which the FUG members are dependent throughout the year and the months for which they are dependent on the particular source is also to be indicated on the chart

- Table 9 – quantity should be mentioned under Availability and requirement not percentages.
- Table 10 has not been filled correctly. The species have to be given scores on a scale of 1 to 10 based on their usefulness by men and women separately. 1 is the lowest score that can be given and 10 is the highest score.
- Table 12 and Table 13 where details of proposed works under Village Forest Development and Livelihood Development have to be given are left blank. Without these tables, it is an incomplete micro plan and based on the data collected especially the status of village forest, the proposed works will have to be discussed with the villagers and details will have to come in the table 12. Same for the livelihood development plan, since this is an initial micro plan the livelihood development plan will be limited to some entry point activities.
- There is no participation of any staff from DMU or FMU in the PRA exercise. It is essential that there is participation from the DMU and FMU in the whole process of micro planning.

Feedback on Micro Plan

- Dubha village is in Babhani block not Myorpur as mentioned in the Micro Plan. The correction needs to be made on the cover page of the micro plan.
- The micro plan should include the names of the Facilitating Team members and the Micro Planning Working Group members.
- Total no. of HHs mentioned is 164 only, which doesn't seem to be correct as the official BPL list available on the website sonbhadra.nic.in shows 191 BPL families in the village and 444 Families are registered under NREGA as shown on nrega.nic.in. Needs to be reviewed and verified

- The no. of members in the FUG is 44% of the total no. of households in the village. As per JFM Rules 2002 a relaxation is needed from the concerned Conservator of Forests in cases where the no. of HHs represented in the FUG is less than 50% of the total HHs in the village. The approval needs to be taken from the concerned Conservator.
- Social map is not legible (Photo copy is of poor quality); a better quality map should be attached.
- In table 9 fodder requirement is not mentioned. Fodder would definitely be a requirement in the village and one of the main produce available from the forest so that needs to be mentioned in table no. 9.
- In table 10 the species have not been given any scores, please note that the species have to be given a score from 1 to 10 based on their perceived importance for the villagers, male and female separately. This exercise should be done as part of the resource mapping exercise in the village.
- Table 12 and Table 13 where details of proposed works under Village Forest Development and Livelihood Development have to be given are not there in the micro plan. Without these tables, it is an incomplete micro plan and based on the data collected especially the status of village forest, the proposed works will have to be discussed with the villagers and details will have to come in the table 12. Same for the livelihood development plan, since this is an initial micro plan the livelihood development plan will be limited to some entry point activities.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vergi verga as verified from the records available in BPL Survey 2002 on the website shrawasti.nic.in and NREGA website is a Gram Panchayat not a revenue village. It has 4 revenue villages – Vergi, Verga, Balupurwa and Gobar which have been mentioned as Hamlets in the Micro Plan. <u>Needs to be reviewed and verified.</u> • The no. of members in the FUG is 46% of the Total no. of Households in the village. As per JFM Rules 2002 a relaxation is needed from the concerned Conservator of Forests in cases where the no. of HHs represented in the FUG is less than 50% of the total HHs in the village. The approval needs to be taken from the concerned Conservator. 		

- There is no participation of any staff from DMU or FMU in the PRA exercise except for the Member Secretary of the JFMC. It is essential that there is participation from the DMU and FMU in the whole process of micro planning.
- The no. of BPL families as mentioned will have to be verified with the official BPL List available on shrawasti.nic.in
- In table no. 5 the landholding based categorization is to be done only for the FUG members not for the total HHs in the village as has been done.
- Section 6 – Status of Village Forest – Table no. 8 – 11 have been left blank, which will make it very difficult to plan for village forest development. The information needs to be filled in the tables to know the status of the village forest.
- Table 12 and Table 13 where details of proposed works under Village Forest Development and Livelihood Development have to be given are left blank. Without these tables, it is an incomplete micro plan and based on the data collected especially the status of village forest, the proposed works will have to be discussed with the villagers and details will have to come in the table 12. Same for the livelihood development plan, since this is an initial micro plan the livelihood development plan will be limited to some entry point activities.

Please note that the duration of the micro plan is 5 years and that is what should be mentioned on the cover page. • The micro plan should include the names of the Facilitating Team members and the Micro Planning Working Group members. • Table no. 2 (Details of FUG Members) is missing and needs to be included. • The no. of BPL families as mentioned will have to be verified with the official BPL List available on sonbhadra.nic.in 		

- Table no. 6 – Water Sources and Table no. 7 – Seasonal Calendar are missing and need to be included.
- Table no. 8 – Status of village forest is missing and needs to be included.
- Table 9 – quantity should be mentioned under Availability and requirement not percentages.
- Table 10 has not been filled correctly. The species have to be given scores on a scale of 1 to 10 based on their usefulness by men and women separately. 1 is the lowest score that can be given and 10 is the highest score.
- Table 12 and Table 13 where details of proposed works under Village Forest Development and Livelihood Development have to be given are missing. Without these tables, it is an incomplete micro plan and based on the data collected especially the status of village forest, the proposed works will have to be discussed with the villagers and details will have to come in the table 12. Same for the livelihood development plan, since this is an initial micro plan the livelihood development plan will be limited to some entry point activities.
